Spruce Grove is a growing, vibrant community with a small-town feel and big-city amenities.

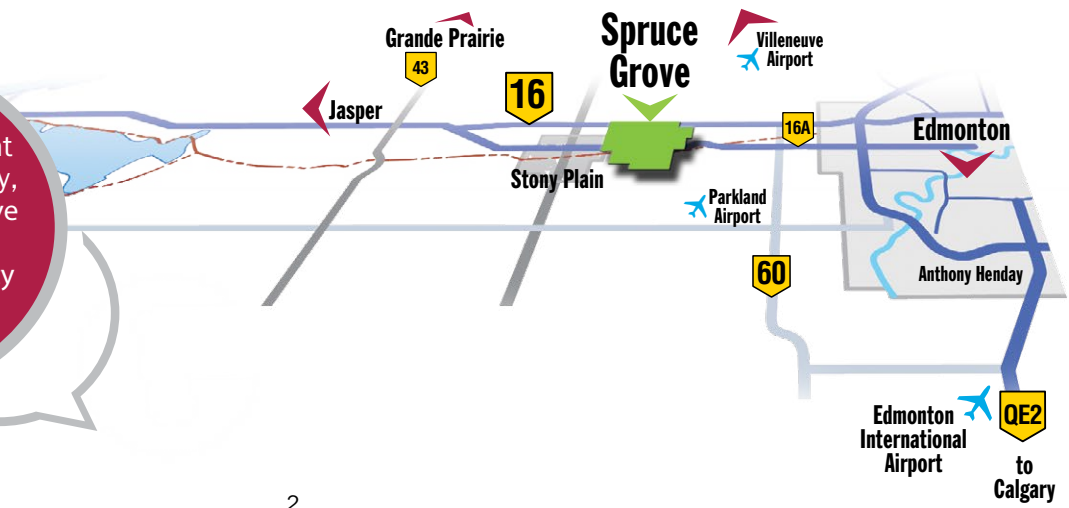

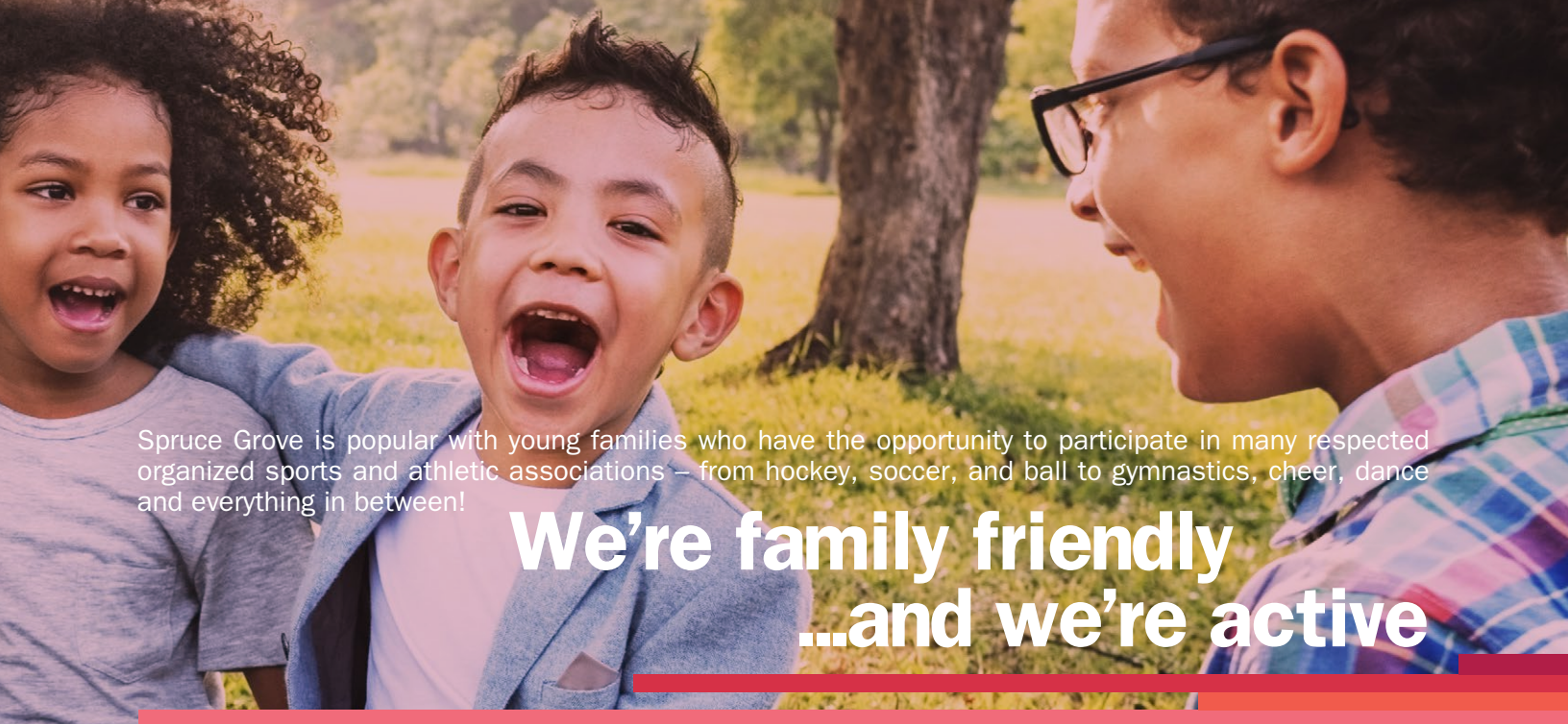

Designed to use 100% recycled water, the spray park's re-circulating water system filters 20,000 gallons of water every hour, making the park both water and energy efficient.

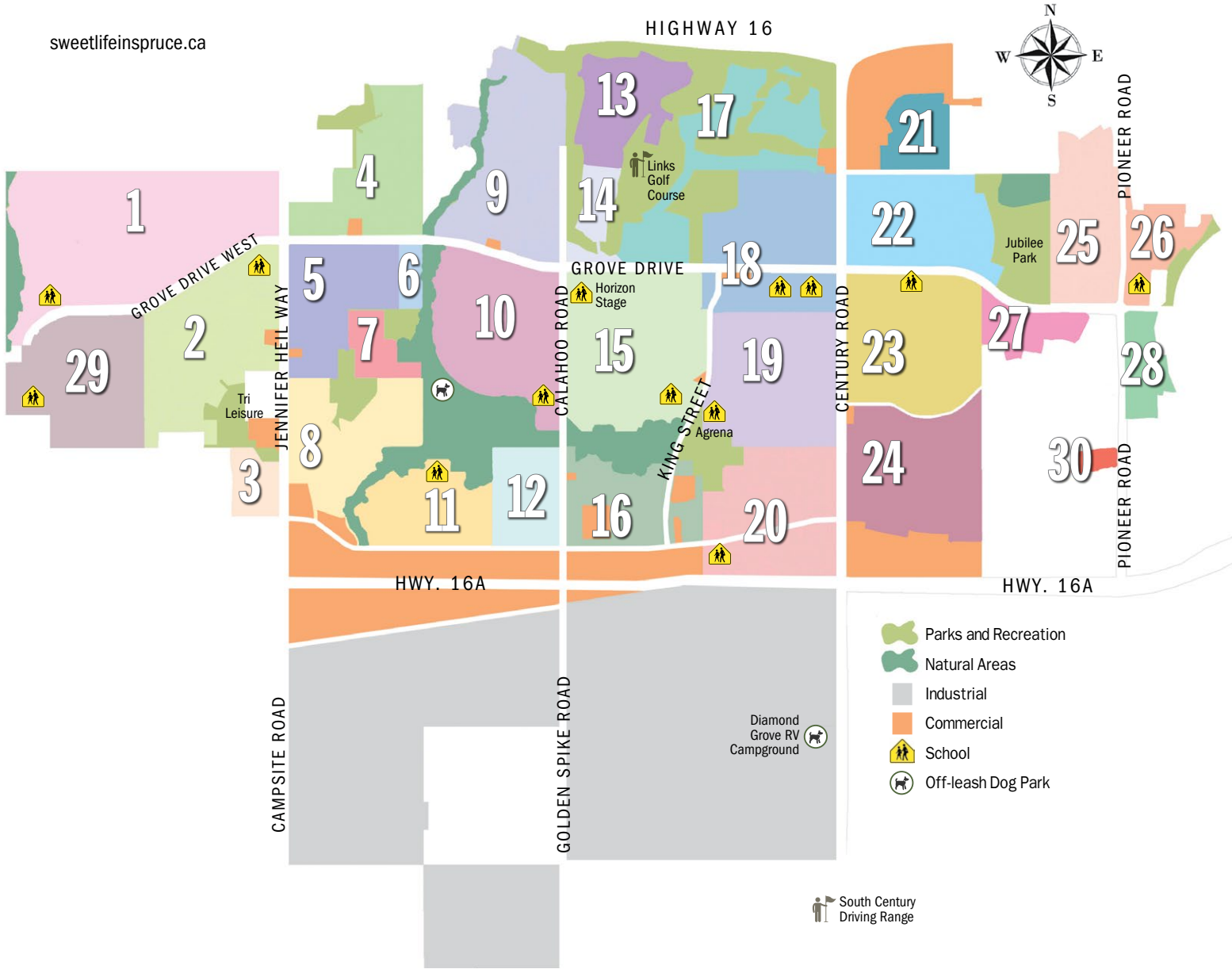

## We're a sustainable, green city

Modern urban design and a commitment to our environment ensure the preservation of our community's many magnificent natural spaces for generations to come.

Spruce Grove undertakes environmental initiatives, including sustainable neighbourhoods and implementing green policies and standards into City operations. Between 1996 and 2015, Spruce Grove decreased its total greenhouse gas emissions (on a per capita basis) by 21% and saw a reduction in residential greenhouse gas emissions (on a per capita basis) by 43%. Between 2016 and 2017, Spruce Grove reduced residential water consumption by 10%.

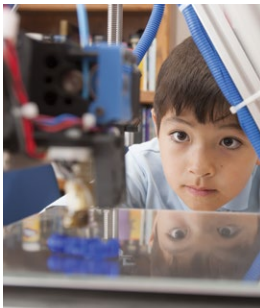
## Public transit

Public transit enhancements within the tri-region and into Edmonton provide residents convenient, economical and environmentally friendly commuter transit service.

Spruce Grove added 6 new city buses, 15 paved bus stop pads, and expanded destinations. With a 17% increase in transit ridership last year, there were 107,567 total transit riders!

Specialized Transit Service (STS) provides local and regional door-to-door service to all seniors (aged 55+) and individuals with mobility challenges living in Spruce Grove.

### Spruce Grove Art Gallery

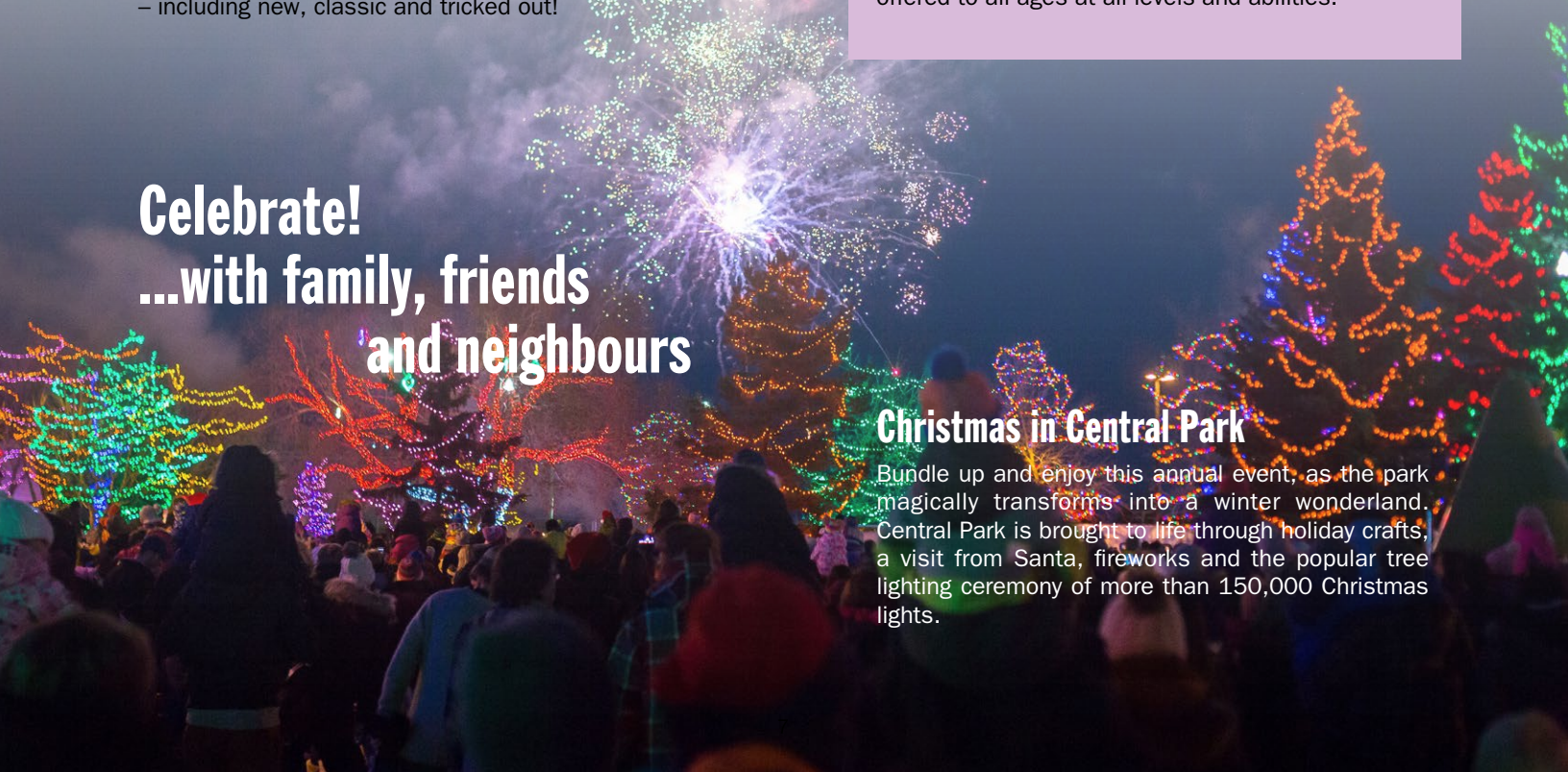
The Art Gallery displays original artwork of local and Alberta artists, including annual feature artist exhibitions.

## Emergency and protective services offer peace of mind

Through high standard, integrated services, Spruce Grove's local RCMP detachment, community peace officers and fire and emergency medical services (EMS) keep residents and businesses safe 24/7.

The expansion of Spruce Grove's fire and EMS building will provide extra space for administrative offices, equipment bays, dormitories and training areas. The city's fire, ambulatory and enforcement services will have a state-of-the-art facility to share.

## New integrated RCMP facility

The 53,000 square foot RCMP facility is a symbol of regional collaboration with the Town of Stony Plain and will house municipal and provincial RCMP, support personnel and a traffic unit.
