The program establishes Digital Service Squads which work directly with small businesses to develop digital transformation plans and adopt digital technologies ranging from websites to Google business profiles, social media, e-commerce and more. Start-up is January 2022 and applications will be considered on a first-come first-serve basis. Applications are being accepted now.



# UPCOMING: Tourism & Hospitality Recovery Program

NEW: Restrictions
Exemption Safety
Training Program



The Alberta Government will

providing support to businesses in the tourism & hospitality industry through the wage and rent subsidy programs, including hotels, travel agencies, restaurants, and others with a subsidy rate of up to 75%.

providing support for businesses that are not in the tourism and hospitality industry, this recovery program provides support for businesses that have faced deep losses, with a subsidy rate of up to 50%.

provide \$1M in grant funding to support frontline workers and help them access safety training to help them keep businesses open and their workers and patrons safe during the pandemic.

# NEW: Alberta REP Implementation Grant



A one-time payment of \$2,000 to Alberta small and medium sized businesses that are eligible for and choose to implement the REP, requiring proof of vaccination, a negative test, or medical exemption.

### Canada Digital Adoption Program



Grow Your Business Online is the first stream where nonprofit organizations are eligible to apply for microgrants that will help support their digital transformation to fuel economic recovery.

## Alberta Jobs Now Program



Private and not-for-profit businesses can apply for funding to offset the cost of hiring and training unemployed or underemployed Albertans. Applications remain open until funding is allocated.

## Alberta's Innovation Employment Grant



Up to a 20% tax credit towards Research and Development phased out for firms with \$10M to \$50M in taxable capital, while providing benefits of up to \$4M in annual Research and Development spending.

#### Canada HASCAP Program



The Highly Affected Sectors Credit Availability Program (HASCAP) provides businesses access to lowinterest loans of \$25,000 to \$1,000,000 to cover cash flow needs. Applications will remain open until Dec 31, 2021.

# Canada-AB Job Grant & Work Sharing Program



The Canada Alberta Job Grant offers funding for training opportunities. The Work Sharing Program provides Employment Insurance benefits for employees who share work while their employer recovers.

#### ☐ SPRUCE GROVE'S SINGLE USE ITEMS REDUCTION BYLAW ☐



Starting January 1, 2022, businesses will no longer be allowed to provide or use plastic checkout bags, polystyrene food serving ware, and plastic straws. The City developed a toolkit to support businesses throughout this transition to provide business owners with information, educational material, and advice on communicating with customers.

## <u>Digital Main Street's</u> ShopHERE Program



This program helps businesses create their online store, provides training and support to go live, and helps with marketing. Sign up here to receive free 1:1 assistance.

# Edmonton Global's Global Growth Trade Service



The Global Growth Trade Service connects businesses with a trade advisor who identifies and helps remove challenges and works with them to implement and activate their entry strategy to international markets.

#### Spruce Grove's Fibre Optic Network



Telus has started construction on a city-wide fibre-optic network for completion by 2023. This includes the fibre build-out in the industrial parks by Q1 2022.

# Edmonton Trade Accelerator Program



This program helps small to medium-sized enterprises reach their global potential by providing them with access to industry experts to develop and execute a personalized marketentry export plan.

# Spruce Grove Permit Activity Reports



Permit activity reports for October 2021 are now available. These reports include building and development permit values, population growth, trends, and more.

# Energy Savings for Business Program



This program provides up to \$55M in funding for Alberta businesses to improve efficiency, reduce emissions, and decrease costs, while creating skilled jobs and boosting economic recovery.
